Foutas and Pinnell (F&P)	K-4	F&P is an individually administered reading inventory of students' reading abilities. Students are assessed on accuracy, fluency, and comprehension questions that yield a level of reading abilities on the Fountas & Pinnell A-Z Text Level Gradient.	
Panorama SEL Screener	K-8	Panorama helps educators support each student's social-emotional wellbeing - the critical skills and mindsets that engage success in school and in life - with a research-backed survey and actionable data reports.	
iReady Diagnostic (Math)	K-8	iReady is a comprehensive assessment and instruction program that empowers educators with the resources they need to help all students succeed.	
GOLD	Pre-K	The GOLD assessment is an authentic part of instruction, not a disruption or separate part of the learning process. Teachers use interactions with, and observations of, children in the classroom as formative assessment practices.
