NEW FIVE-YEAR GAVIN DISTRICT 37 STRATEGIC PLAN APPROVED

Gavin District 37 Board of Education recently approved a new Strategic Plan this past December. The planning process was conducted over the last few months and outlines the mission, vision, core values and goals for the next five years.

District 37 stakeholders
including parents, students, staff, faculty,
administrators and board members
volunteered to participate in this planning
process which enabled stakeholders to
voice and agree on the priorities and
focus for district improvement.

Strategic planning is the equivalent of an organization hitting the "reset" button to insure everyone is on the same page to move the district forward. This comprehensive document communicates the district's goals, the priorities needed to achieve those goals and metrics used to measure progress on those goals over the next five years. It includes both the academic and operational aspects of the school district.

- Why does our district exist as an organization? What's our purpose?
- What is our district's vision? What would we like to look like in the future?
- What are our district's core values or beliefs? How do we behave as an organization?
- What are our district's goals for the future? What do we need to focus on as we move forward?

Collectively, these questions address the four key components of strategic planning: *Mission, Vision, Core Values and Goals.*
