

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

New English Language Arts (ELA) Curriculum Implemented in fall of 2022.

High Reliability Schools™ Partnership |

CONTINUED FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDE NEW CLASSROOM FURNITURE, LIGHTING, AND A PLAYGROUND

FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS

New Furniture to Support Learning Environments | At their January meeting, the Board of Education approved the recommendation of the administration to improve the learning environment in Gavin classrooms. Staff committees were formed at each building in the fall of 2023 to establish learning environments that will better support students' needs. Research also included site visits to other schools. With Board approval, the district is scheduled to have new furniture in 14 classrooms to start the 2024-25 school year, with a plan to continue the project until all learning spaces are upgraded.

Playground at Gavin Central

Staff committees planned and developed an exciting new playground at Gavin Central, and will continue this summer 2024. set to be installed over spring break.

Central Lobby Lighting | Outdated/dim lighting was replaced with brighter and environmentally-friendly LED lighting.

Central Cafeteria Flooring | Flooring past its life expectancy was replaced with fresh vinyl floor tiles.

Internal and External Security Cameras

Additional security cameras were installed in critical areas in and around our buildings.

Parking Lots Upgraded | New pavement and restriping of our parking lots has begun

Technology Upgrades | Wifi and network upgrades provide a safer and more reliable environment for staff and students.

Exterior Grounds | Ongoing work is taking place to beautify our grounds, including landscaping, mulching, tree trimming, professional lawn mowing, and snow removal services, etc.

FINANCIAL HEALTH

Evidence Based Funding (EBF) is a funding formula developed by the Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) that supports Illinois school districts. The goal is to provide funding to schools based on need. The EBF formula is designed to provide school districts with the funds necessary to ensure they have the resources to provide a safe, rigorous, and well-rounded learning environment for all students.


Gavin 37 received \$3,602,624 for the 2023-24 school year, approximately \$400,000 more than last year.

Fund Balance | In fiscal year 2020, Gavin 37 had a total fund balance of \$2,531,387. For fiscal year 2024, the district has a total fund balance of \$6,499,867, with a total overall budget of \$11M. (See chart below.)


692 Chromebooks Acquired | Through the Emergency Connectivity Fund (ECF), Gavin 37 received new Chromebooks for students for the 2023-24 school year. These Chromebooks provide students with a 1:1 device to support their learning needs while significantly improving the district's ability to keep our students safe online.

Highest Financial Recognition by State | Thanks to dedicated financial management, Gavin 37 was rated 3.9/4.0 in the last financial audit, and earned a financial designation of "Recognized" which is the highest designation an Illinois school district can achieve. (See chart below.)
