Dear Gavin D37 Parents/Guardians,

Happy belated Mother's Day! I hope this message continues to find you and your families safe, warm, and well.

There are so many moving parts associated with this pandemic that every day a new change or procedure comes our way.

Based upon the recent changes by the Illinois State Board of Education with the Act Of God (AOG) days, we have learned that our Spring Break of 5 days was replaced with AOG days which are now considered Student Attendance Days. That means we can alter the end of our school year to reflect those additional days on our calendar. In addition, we were given 5 remote learning planning dates. We have used 2 and 1/2 of those dates for teacher planning and have 2 and 1/2 remaining dates.

Here is what this translates into:

- May 20 Last Instructional Day for Students. Students will have until May 27 to complete missing work.
- May 21 Remote Learning Planning Day for Staff
- May 21 8th Grade Drive In Graduation Ceremony
- May 22 Institute Day for Staff No School
- May 25 Memorial Day No School
- May 26 Remote Learning Planning Day for Staff
- May 27 Remote Learning Planning Half Day for Staff End of School Year

During those Remote Learning Planning dates with Staff:

- We will create some packets or lists of suggestions for summer work for students. We will have those available for families.
- I will work on a survey about remote learning for parents and staff and students. I will ask Ms. Lisa Adler, our Tech Coach, to co-present to the Board about our findings and her work with staff and students.
- Students will have until May 27 to turn in any incomplete work, and it will count.
- We will prepare for a variety of options for school's start in Fall 2020, and these opportunities will be shared with families in June.

We will be providing a package that includes cold breakfasts and lunches for our students that receive free and reduced lunch for the week May 18. Locker/Desk Items Pick Up & Device, Instruments, Library Book Drop Off

Our custodians and staff are putting locker (including gym lockers at South) and desk (Central) items in bags for parents to pick up. These bags will be organized by last name so it is easier for families to collect these items at each school during the days of May 19-June 2. Please see the below schedule for returning devices, instruments, and/or library books and to collect your child's/children's items from lockers and desks at each school building:

Procedures:

- 1. There will be a sign-up sheet provided at a table outside the front entrance door at Central and the side gym doors at South.
- 2. You will come to the table, sign the sheet, and share your name with one of our staff members who will bring the bag of items to you.
- 3. Once the bag of items is collected, it will be placed outside the door for you to pick up and take home.
- 4. Library books, devices, and instruments must be returned in the bins next to the table.

Grading/Reporting

It is important for students to complete their remote learning assignments or their grade will be considered incomplete. Grades cannot go down, and the first two trimesters will be used to determine grades, unless a student has really shown substantial growth. Student grades for Trimester 3 will be based upon **work completion** and will either be *Pass* or *Incomplete*. Students with IEP goals will be provided an update about progress toward their goals through email at the end of the trimester; goals are either marked complete or in progress.

Our current remote learning plan will take us through Governor Pritzker's end-of-school-year closing Executive Order. We will continue to communicate with you about the options for Fall 2020. Once again, thanks for your patience, and support.
