**Pre-K-8 Remote Learning Guidelines**

**Instruction**     What can you expect from our full remote learning plan?

**Central School Hours:**

Pre-Kindergarten:

AM Pre-Kindergarten - 8:40 to 10:55 a.m.

PM Pre-Kindergarten - 12:00 to 2:15 p.m.

K-4: 8:40 - 2:15 with lunch break M, T, Th, Fr

K-4: 8:20 - 1:20 p.m. Wednesdays

**South School Hours:**

5-8: 7:45 a.m. - 1:20 p.m. with lunch break M, T, Th, Fr

5-8: 7:45 a.m. - 12:45 p.m. Wednesdays

- Consistent Daily schedule for students
- Instructional day will consist of 5 hours of daily instruction (2.5 hours for Pre-K), including 2 hours and 30 minutes of Live (synchronous) (1 hour and 30 minutes for Pre-K) instruction.
- Small Group instruction will be provided by classroom teacher based upon the needs of students
- Students will receive Specials as scheduled: Art, STEM, PE, and/or Music
- Differentiated Small group interventions will be provided to identified students including English learner support
- Special education, related services will be provided in conjunction with the student's teacher and/or in intervention groups of general instruction, depending on each student's IEP.

**Grading and Attendance** Standards based K-6 and traditional 7-8 grading will be used based on formative and summative assessments from both live assessment and completed work.

**Meet and Greet Days** Meet and Greet is an opportunity for families to connect with their classroom teacher before the first student instructional day. Meet and Greets will be scheduled via Skyward (much like parent-teacher conferences). The link to sign up will be sent out during the week of August 17.

Tuesday, August 25: 3:00 to 6:00 p.m.

Wednesday, August 26: 9:00 to 11:00 a.m.

Teachers will start instruction on Thursday, August 27 and will explain the learning schedule for the Remote Learning time.

Pre-K will host a separate evening for Meet and Greet. This will be sent directly to those families.

**Learning Materials and Laptop Pick Up** Learning materials will be provided for all students. Students in grades K-8 will be assigned a laptop. The link to sign up for a Meet and Greet time will be sent out during the week of August 17th .

**Food Service** On Fridays, food distribution will continue to be offered for families who have opted in, for pick up and/or at select community locations.

**Teacher Information** Families will be alerted when their child's teacher at Central and schedule at South are available for review the week of August 17th.

A digital device for every individual student K-8 will be provided. Google Classroom will be the hub for all instructional online resources. When picking up devices during Meet and Greet times, directions for logging in will be provided.
